

Gettysburg Field Trip October 11, 2008

The Restored 123 year old 360-degree Cyclorama & “Gettysburg’s Seldom Seen” with our guide Gary Kross

Join the Harrisburg Civil War Roundtable and the Hershey Civil War Roundtable for a day of exploring history and paranormal phenomena.

In the morning we will visit the newly-completed \$103 million museum and visitor center. The oil painting is 365 feet long and 42 feet high. Completed in 1884, it is designed to place the viewer in the middle of the climactic, ill-fated Confederate assault focusing on Pickett’s Charge. We will also see the feature film “ A New Birth of Freedom”. You will also have time to tour the 11 different galleries each with its own story to tell.

In the afternoon, our Guide Gary Kross will take us around Gettysburg to explore the “Seldom Seen.” This is going to be an interesting and memorable experience. Joining us on the bus trip to Gettysburg will be John Weaver, representing the Spirit Society of PA, who encourages a responsible approach to investigating the paranormal- you will find him an informative resource.

The price of the tour is \$65, which includes transportation from pick-up points in Hummelstown and Harrisburg, all admissions and tips. Lunch in Gettysburg is on your own.
